



# Aboriginal Person Centred Care Training

## **Learning & Development: Health Literacy**

Person Centred Care takes in to account the needs of the person, and supports strength based approaches. Through the adoption of this approach, participants can help support a culturally safe environment in their Health Services for Aboriginal people (inclusive of patients, clients and the Aboriginal workforce).

The full day session comprises of 4 Modules which allow participants the opportunity to explore Aboriginal experiences around identity, reflect on the shared local history of the Health Service region, challenge their own worldviews, and to view patient journeys through a cultural lens.

The team engages participants through the sharing of individual and collective stories, and training outcomes include being able to positively impact on the health and wellbeing of Aboriginal people.
