



## Falls Management: ALLIED HEALTH

This clinical program aims to increase the knowledge and skills of Allied Health staff in assessing patients for fall risks, minimising the likelihood of fall-related injuries, and effectively managing actual fall events.

This day is similar to the Advanced Falls Days run over the last few years but has been refreshed, with different speakers and some alternative topics. It continues to provide the latest evidence and practical skills to incorporate into practice.

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### Learning objectives

After attending this program, the learner will:

- Develop increased understanding and skills in a variety of falls risk factors e.g. continence, diabetes, syncope/cardiac, nutrition, long COVID, neuropathy, stroke, vestibular assessment, concern about falling, patient education and case studies.
- Promote and develop an awareness and implementation of strategies used to minimise the risk of falls in hospital for patients suffering with the above.
- Develop skills/knowledge that can be implemented into practice.
