Preceptor (Teaching on the Run – day 1)

This **Professional** program provides four (4) workshops from the TOTR series developed by TELL Centre, Smart Moves Consultancy. These workshops include:

- Clinical Supervision
- Supporting Learners
- Clinical Teaching
- Assessment

It is designed as a blended learning format which includes pre-reading activities and enables participants to apply sound teaching and learning principles. It is delivered by accredited TOTR inter-professional facilitators.

Participants may choose to attend TOTR individual sessions or the full day

Learning objectives

After attending this program, the learner will:

- Understand the importance in planning for and recognising opportunities for teaching and learning experiences in the clinical area
- In the clinical setting, utilise strategies and tools learned in this program to support learners
- Develop and consolidate skills in clinical teaching
