



Vascular Study Day

This **Clinical** program provides a basic understanding of the clinical assessment and management of patients with vascular disease and includes sessions on surgical management. Clinical experts will present interactive sessions that will improve participant knowledge on how to identify and manage potential complications often faced by vascular patients.

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Learning objectives

After attending this program, the learner will:

- Discuss the pathophysiology of vascular disease
- In the clinical setting, use the knowledge I have gained to perform a comprehensive vascular assessment
- Identify the referral pathways for clinical experts, radiological interventions and other hospital resources to engage them in the care of the complex co-morbid patient with vascular disease
- Apply new knowledge and understanding to the care for complex medical and surgical co-morbid vascular patients
