## **Tracheostomy Unzipped**

Description		This interactive program is designed to enhance participants' knowledge, practical skills and confidence in managing a patient with a tracheostomy, from basic care to emergency management.			
		This eight-hour PD program is delivered over a five week period utilizing a 'flipped classroom' methodology. The flipped classroom is a type of blended learning characterised by participants completing on-line learning that provides foundation knowledge prior to attending a class where active learning strategies are employed to build on that foundation knowledge. This will be done in week 5 with a hands on demo and practical workshop with the facilitiators. Participants will be able to practice, consolidate their knowledge and ask questions in a safe learning environment.			
Who should enrol?		All nurses and health care professionals employed by SCGH or OPH working in a healthcare service who can commit to two hours of learning per week for the duration of the program.
