Tracheostomy Unzipped

Description	<p>This interactive program is designed to enhance participants' knowledge, practical skills and confidence in managing a patient with a tracheostomy, from basic care to emergency management.</p> <p>This eight-hour PD program is delivered over a five week period utilizing a 'flipped classroom' methodology. The flipped classroom is a type of blended learning characterised by participants completing on-line learning that provides foundation knowledge prior to attending a class where active learning strategies are employed to build on that foundation knowledge. This will be done in week 5 with a hands on demo and practical workshop with the facilitators. Participants will be able to practice, consolidate their knowledge and ask questions in a safe learning environment.</p>		
Who should enrol?	All nurses and health care professionals employed by SCGH or OPH working in a healthcare service who can commit to two hours of learning per week for the duration of the program.		
Special Note	Participants will not be granted access to learning content without successful completion of the weekly learning activities. Progression is monitored and supported by the G64 SDN facilitators and the CNE facilitation team.
