Empowering SRNs: The Business of Nursing

This program provides and enables nurses working towards or employed in leadership positions to understand how the business of a hospital is managed and how this supports their role in nursing. Nurses will participate in interactive sessions to explore how resources are allocated and managed, and able to consider how data is used across the organisation to inform practice and service design.
